Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	0,1 %

Exemptions listed in Annex III or IV of Directive may apply.

On 31 March 2015 4 additional substances have been added to Annex II of the RoHS Directive. The new substance restrictions apply for EEE that is placed on the market from 22. July 2019 and from 22. July 2021 for EEE category 8 and 9 (Medical devices, Monitoring and Control Instruments). In case changes affecting our products will take place, we will inform our customers in a timely manner about changes and, where applicable, about substitutions.
